Child and Youth Health



Your child's health and development are important. Child and Youth Health is there to help you. We would like to invite you and your child for a health check. This leaflet tells you what the health check involves. You can also read about what we do with the results of the check-up.

Check-up

The paediatric nurse or paediatrician checks the health and development of primary school children. There are two health checks: one when the children are 5 years old and another when they are 10 years old. This means that you and your child can be given help and support quickly if you need it. Taking part in the health check is voluntary.

The check-up consists of:

- A digital questionnaire
- Measurements
- In some cases, an appointment

Digital questionnaire

You can complete the digital questionnaire at home. You can find the questionnaire on the website: jijenjegezondheid.nl > log in > primary education. Log in using the log-in code and your child's date of birth. You can find the log-in code in the invitation letter. After completing the questionnaire, you will be given more information and advice straight away.

Measurements

The doctor's assistant will measure your child's height and weight at school. Your child will remain fully clothed. If your child is aged 5, the doctor's assistant will also do an eye test and an ear test. As a parent, you do not need to be there during the check-up. But you can be there if you want. If you would like to attend the check-up with your child, or if you do not want your child to take part in the check-up, please call +31 (0)20 555 5964. Your child will be given a letter with the results of the examination to take home with them.

Appointment

Sometimes, we will invite you and your child to attend an appointment. The appointment will be about your child's health and development. You can also ask any questions you may have. The invitation letter will tell you what to expect at your child's school.

Privacy

Sometimes the paediatric nurse or paediatrician will talk to the internal counsellor or a teacher at school about your child. But this will only happen with your consent. Your answers to the questionnaires are kept securely. Only the doctor's assistant, paediatrician and paediatric nurse can see the completed questionnaire. Scientific research

At the end of each school year, Child and Youth Health removes all names from the questionnaire. Scientists can then use the anonymous data for research. You can opt out of this for your child if you want. If you wish to opt out, please indicate this in the digital questionnaire.
